

The South Central Planning and Development Commission Board of Commissioners will hold a meeting on Thursday, April 15th, 2021 at 10:30am. In an effort to reduce and limit the spread of COVID-19 in Louisiana, and to preserve the health and safety of all members of the public, the Governor has declared the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency and ordered that is necessary to limit public gatherings in a single place in an effort to avoid individuals being in close proximity to one another.

Therefore, in accordance with Section 4 of Governor's Proclamation Number 30 JBE 2020: Additional Measures for COVID-19 Public Health Emergency, South Central Planning and Development Commission Board of Commissioners will hold its April 15th, 2021 meeting virtually utilizing the online platform "Zoom" and livestream the meeting.
